Rules Quiz:



1. What’s the penalty for playing outside the teeing ground?

2. Relief from Water Hazard (yellow stakes) ?

Answers: 1. In Match Play if a player plays outside the teeing ground there is no penalty but the opponent may require the player to replay the ball. In stroke play if a competitor when starting a hole outside the teeing ground - occurs a two stroke penalty and must replay.
Rule 11-4

2. One stroke and replay shot. Or one stroke penalty and drop behind the hazard along a line from the pin to where the ball last crossed the hazard. Or play from hazard without grounding the club.
