

OPEN WEEK 2018 @ SKERRIES GOLF CLUB

The Open Week time sheets are now open for bookings; however, some members are experiencing certain concerns / difficulties when trying to book. So I would like to detail a step by step guide that will hopefully help you get over these concerns / difficulties.

Alternatively, the Office Staff would as always be happy to answer any queries you have or help you make a booking.

ENTRY FEES

This year's Entry Fees for all 18 Hole Competitions will be $10 \in$ for Members and $20 \in$ for Visitors. 9 Hole Singles competitions will be $5 \in$ for Members and $10 \in$ for Visitors. 9 Hole Foursomes will be $2.50 \in$ for Members and $7.50 \in$ for Visitors.

TO BOOK - 18 HOLE COMPETITIONS

This year all 18 Hole Competitions will be booked through BRS Online and Pre-paid. To Book an 18 Hole Open Competition, there are basically three stages to making your booking -

Stage One - Selecting the Competition Stage Two - Entering your Personal Details Stage Three - Entering your Payment Details

STAGE ONE – Selecting the Competition

*Go to the Club's web site, namely www.skerriesgolfclub.ie

*On the home page (Which is the first screen that appears) click on 'VISITOR TEE TIMES' on the bottom Left Hand side of the Home page and DO NOT enter by clicking on 'Member Tee Times' (NB This is the most common mistake members are making).

- *On the screen that appears 'VISITOR Online Tee Time Reservation Service' -click on 'Book an Open Competition'
- *On the screen that appears -,'Open Competitions Online Reservations' select the relevant competition, and click on the 'Book Now' on the Right Hand Side
- *On the screen that appears 'Open Competition Tee Time Availability' select your preferred tee time and then enter the number or members/visitors for Teams events you enter them in pairs i.e. 2 Members, 1 Member and 1 Visitor, or 2 Visitors. For Singles you enter either a Member or Visitor. Once entered, click on the 'Book Now' tab on the Right Hand Side.

STAGE TWO - Entering your Personal Details

*This brings you to the 'Personal Details' screen – which has a summary of your booking at the top, under which you need to enter your 'Personal Details'. All sections with an asterix must be completed.

Due to GDPR Regulations, you must also tick a) Your Marketing Preferences; b) The Privacy Policy and Visitor Terms & Conditions.

Then you will be asked to enter the additional players' names, once done click on 'Proceed' button.

*The 'Personal Details Summary, then appears – where you can check the details of your booking, if no amendments are required click on 'Complete Booking'.

STAGE THREE - Entering your Payment Details

This will then bring you to the final stage of the booking process namely the payment process.

*First you are asked to select the Payment means
On the Left Hand side of the screen it shows you the amount to pay.

*Next you enter your Payment Card Details – you are asked to confirm your Name, Card Number (This is the long 16 digit number), the Expiry Date and the CVC (the last three digits of the security code on the reverse of the card.) Then click the green button 'Confirm Card Details'

You will then receive a Booking Confirmation Email, confirming your booking details and payment.

NB Unfortunately, you must do this per line booked.

TO BOOK - 9 HOLE COMPETITIONS

All 9 Hole Competitions may be booked as a normal Member Competition, again through BRS Online, but with Payment taken when you register on the day of the competition.

Under GUI/ILGU guidelines all Participants in Open Week Competitions will be required to swipe in before commencing play using a valid GUI/ILGU Membership Card.

For those members without Debit/Credit Cards, Booking sheets will be available in the Main Office, where the staff will be happy to make competitions bookings subject to availability and payment will be taken at the time of booking.

Finally, Open Week is an Opportunity to 'Showcase' our fine club to visitors and friends alike, so please can I encourage you not only to book but also spread the word and encourage your golfing associates to book and experience the warmth, camaraderie and style that is Skerries Golf Club.

Please remember though, if you are experiencing any concerns / difficulties, please contact the office and the staff will be more than happy to assist you.
