

Skerries Golf Club Cadet and Junior Admissions Priority Order

In the event the Cadet and/or Junior Section(s) is oversubscribed with new applications, the following Order of Admission will apply, in order to safely manage the Sections in accordance with the number of volunteers available:

- 1. Graduates of the Club's Cadets Programme (Applies to Junior Section Only)**
- 2. Children of Ordinary Members**
- 3. Grandchildren of Ordinary Members**
- 4. Children of 5 day Members**
- 5. Grandchildren of 5 day Members**
- 6. Siblings of Current Cadets and/or Junior Members**
- 7. Other relatives of Ordinary Members**
- 8. Other relatives of 5 day Members**
- 9. Children of Pavillion Members**
- 10. Grandchildren of Pavillion Members**
- 11. Local Residents / Immediate Community**
- 12. General Public**

Note:

- The opening date for receipt of new applications to join as a Cadet or Junior Member is 1st January, annually.
- The closing date for receipt of new applications to join as a Cadet or Junior Member is 28th February, annually.
- Within each category, applications will be ordered first based on the duration of the Ordinary/5 Day/Pavillion members' membership.
- Within each category, applications will be ordered second based on the date of receipt of a fully completed application.
- If a Cadets' or Juniors' membership lapses and re-applies for membership the following year or in subsequent years, the Admissions Priority Order will apply to the latter application.
- Overall Cadet and Junior membership will be reviewed annually. The Junior Committee reserves the right to cancel the membership of Junior members who do not play a minimum number of 6 9 hole rounds/attend coaching sessions during the year, or Cadets who do not attend 3 coaching or Sunday evening sessions during the year..
- A waiting list for Cadet and Junior Members will **not** be maintained.
- The Junior Committee reserves the right to make exceptions to the Admission Policy where it deems appropriate.
